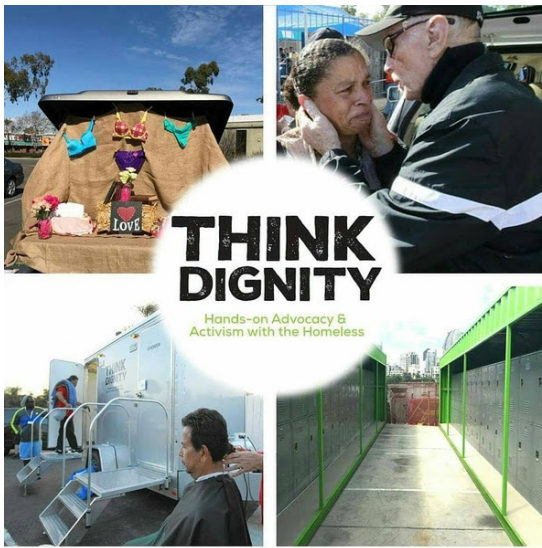
SURVIVAL SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION

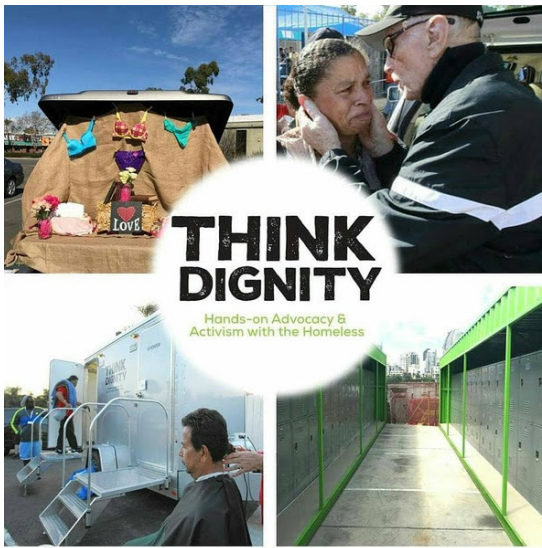
SURVIVAL SUPPLY DISTRIBUTION
