COVID-19 RESPONSE

In compliance with California Governor Gavin Newsom's public health stay-at-home order and guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), World Health Organization (WHO), and federal and local guidelines and to ensure the safety of our community and staff, **our Mobile Operations of Dignity (MOD) Squad programs will continue to remain closed until Saturday, April 18th. Our Legal Clinics will continue to operate virtually from Monday to Friday (9:00am - 4:30pm) and our Transitional Storage Center (TSC) has continued to open during regular business hours.** We will continue to monitor the situation and conduct program re-assessments in mid-April.

In lieu of our MOD Squad programs, **we will continue to create and distribute hygiene kits to our operating community partners.** As fellow Dignity Defenders, we would like to ask for your support in allowing us to continue this work by donating hygiene kit items through our Amazon Wishlist, selecting Think Dignity as your beneficiary for Amazon Smile purchases, and/or joining us as a Sustaining Member. 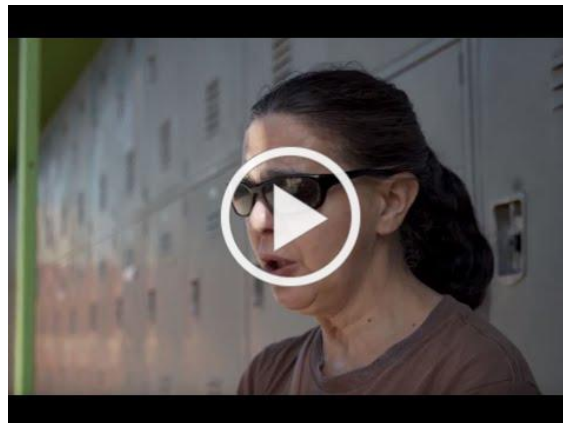
