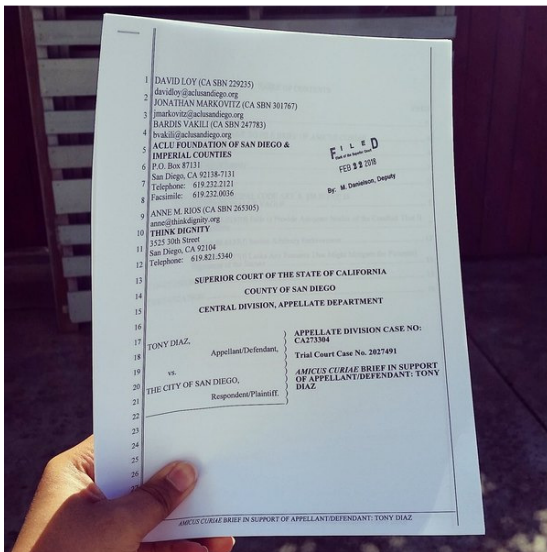

STOP CRIMINALIZING HOMELESSNESS

On Thursday, February 22nd, we filed an Amicus Brief with ACLU San Diego to support the case against the City of San Diego, which aims to stop the criminalization of those living in their vehicles. Tony Diaz, the defendant in the case, was cited for living in his vehicle based on a vague statute that discriminates those who are experiencing homelessness in San Diego County.
